This funding will be used to

- Ensure 100% of students, not working to an Individual Curriculum Plan (ICP), achieve DDSW Reading benchmarks.
- Ensure 100% of Year 3 and Year 5 students exceed the National Minimum Standard (NMS) in NAPLAN Writing in 2018.
- Ensure the consistency of teacher judgement around A-E achievement standards.

Our initiatives include

- Building teacher capability in the explicit teaching of Writing
- Embedding whole school Literacy blocks four days a week.
- Developing teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum content descriptions and achievement standards by supporting processes for robust school level and cluster level moderation.
- Developing staff knowledge and skills to effectively bridge data collection and improved instruction.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Teachers engaging with cluster collaboration days, targeting the explicit teaching of Writing.	\$1600
• Teachers participating in the 'Leading Learning Collaborative Project' to build data skills.	\$1600
• Purchasing additional teacher aide time to support the daily explicit teaching of Reading, Spelling and Writing.	\$4088
• Providing teachers with a robust moderation process with which to engage, resulting in the collective sharing of effective strategies in planning next steps for instruction.	\$800
